**All systems must have a backflow test on record for the year of service. If Thomas Irrigation does not test your Backflow device, then your device must be tagged by a licensed tester.**

### Backflow Testing

There have recently been several cities subcontract their Backflow certification management. Along with that comes some surcharges that we just wanted to explain to you. We get charged a processing fee for every backflow test that we submit to these companies. These companies are BSI and Aqua Backflow. Below are the affected Cities/Towns as well as the surcharges that come with them.

Below you will find general information regarding your backflow.

- Why am I required to have a backflow device with my irrigation system?**  
 Per 327 IAC 8-10-6: Customers shall construct an air gap or install a reduced pressure (RP) principal backflow or pressure type vacuum breaker (PVB) on the water line connecting the public water supply to any land irrigation facility buried below ground which as a sprinkling outlet located less than six (6) inches above grade, and which is constructed after July 19, 1985.
- How often should your backflow device be inspected?**  
 Once a calendar year. At every start-up, the backflow device must be tested as well.
- Who governs the regulations?**  
 The State of Indiana governs cross connection control and backflow prevention through the Indian Administrative Code (regulations).
- When will my results be submitted?**  
 Test results will be submitted when payment has been received for work performed, including submission fees.
